
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



Library scavenger hunt

For a rainy day, try a Library Scavenger Hunt! After traveling to your community library, have a parent or guardian ask you to find a specific book (example: Diary of a Wimpy Kid, a dictionary, a book written in a different language). After finding the book, show it to your parent/guardian and request the next clue!

Make sure to be quiet, and no running!!

Research your community library's events!

Each and every library has a multitude of events for kids! Either go online to your library's website, or ask a librarian at your local chapter what activities are being offered.

Get a library card

First off, what does a library card do for you?

A library card allows you to borrow books from the library. Once you have chosen your book, a machine scans your library card barcode and then scans the book barcode. This process tells the library system that you are checking out that specific book. If you keep the book for too long or someone else wants to borrow it, the library will let you know it's time to bring it back.

Here is how it works:

- Go to the library with a parent or guardian.
- Tell a librarian that you would like to apply for a library card.
- He or she will ask you to complete a form.
- Fill out the form with your parent or guardian.
- Sign and activate your library card.
- Now it's ready for use!!


Why should I get a book from the library?

- It is free.
- If you don't like the book, you can return it and get a new one.
 There is no stress of buying a book you don't like!
- Librarians can help you find a book you will like!

Here are some GREAT things to do outdoors during springtime!!


- Fly a kite, play frisbee or go on the swingset at Heritage Farm Neighborhood Park (9520 Hall Road, Potomac)

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HOW TO MAKE A WIND CHIME

Materials:

- Stick or log
- Beads/charms
- Mini bells
- String





Instructions:

- Step 1: Find a stick in your backyard that is somewhat straight and will not snap easily.
- Step 2: Cut a piece of string twice as long as the stick.
- Step 3: Tie each end of the string to the stick. This will be used to hang the wind chime.
- Step 4: Take another piece of string 11 inches long and tie a big knot at the end (big enough so the beads won't fall off).
- Step 5: String beads and mini bells, leaving three inches of space at the top with no beads.
- Step 6: Using the three extra inches of string, tie the string of beads to the stick.
- Step 7: Do this four more times. You can vary the length of the strings, or keep them all the same.
- Step 8: YOU ARE DONE!
- Step 9: Hang your masterpiece outside so you can hear the chimes sing!

Watermelon Pizza

MAKE SURE TO HAVE AN ADULT PRESENT FOR THIS

Ingredients:

- Any type of fruit: strawberries (sliced thinly), blueberries, raspberries, blackberries, etc.
- Yogurt (any type)
- Watermelon
- OPTIONAL: chocolate chips



Step 1: Have an adult cut circles from a whole watermelon or semi-circles from a half. These slices should be thin.

Step 2: Spread yogurt thinly on top of the watermelon slices.

Step 3: Place the assorted berries on top of yogurt!

Step 4: OPTIONAL: Add some chocolate chips.

Flower Pretzel Snack Bites MAKE SURE TO HAVE AN ADULT PRESENT FOR THIS

Ingredients:

- Grid-shaped pretzels
- Hershey kisses
- Colored M&Ms (preferably spring colors)




- Step 1: Preheat the oven to 175 degrees.
- Step 2: Place pretzels (as many as can fit) onto a baking sheet.
- Step 3: Place a single Hershey kiss on each of the pretzels.
- Step 4: Warm pretzels in the oven until the Hershey kiss is slightly soft (usually 2 minutes).
- Step 5: Remove baking sheet from oven.
- Step 6: Place a colorful M&M on top of each Hershey kiss and press down slightly.
- Step 7: Place six different colored M&Ms around the center one, making a flower.
- Step 8: Chill baking sheet in the refrigerator for 10 minutes.
- Step 9: Share the yummy flavor kisses with your family and friends! ENJOY!


